Individual Student Items

- Organizer: Students need a way to **organize four content classes** (ELA, Math, Science and Social Studies). Work with your student to decide which works best for them.
ONE of the following:
 - Individual folders – one per class
 - Accordion folder – one folder per class
 - Spiral notebooks – one per class
 - Binder – dividers per class
 - Composition books – one per class
 - Plastic Envelopes – one per class
 - Other organizational systems
- Math Journal – can be spiral bound, composition book, steno book, etc...
- Personal pens, pencils, erasers, highlighters, etc...
- Algebra II and higher math students** require a TI Graphing Calculator (TI 83 or higher)
- Students may bring a personal laptop or other device.
